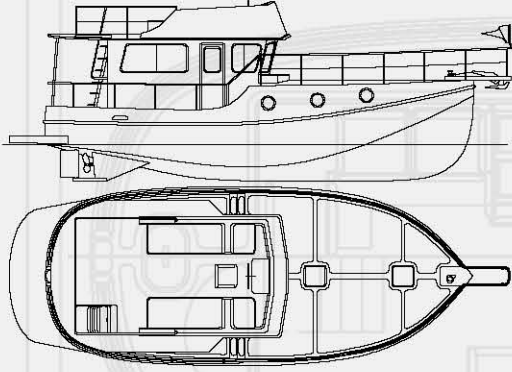




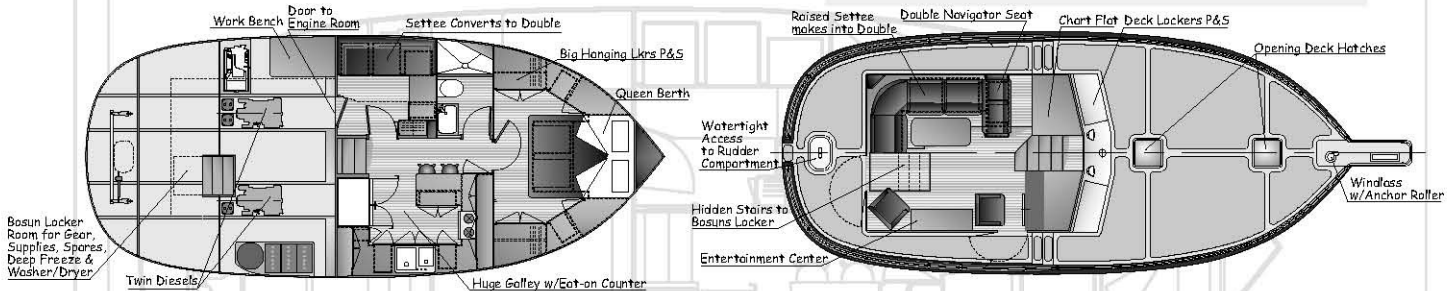

The optional flybridge provides seating for the entire crew with a swivel chair, two forward-facing seats and a pair of 6' 6" benches. And there's still plenty of room for a skiff and deck chairs!

Safe & Strong

The Great Harbour N37 is built to take it with engineering borrowed from commercial craft—her overbuilt hull has glass thicknesses similar to those found in most fifty footers:

- Solid fiberglass hull with full-length stringers & 5 watertight bulkheads below cabin soles
- Lifetime integral fiberglass tanks
- Light weight, vacuum-bagged core superstructure—bonded to hull with bi-axial fiberglass rovings for total integrity
- Beamy hard-chined hull with low center of gravity for the ultimate in form stability
- Twin diesels standard (8 knot max cruise, 7 knot "take home" cruise with single motor)
- Twin load-bearing skegs with rudder shoes protecting props & rudders



Long Range

The Great Harbour N37 lets you stay away longer—whether you're looking to put more miles under your keel or want to hang out longer in the islands—you can carry more fuel & supplies on a N37. With cruises to Bermuda and Hawaii this past year, the N37 "Has the Right Stuff!"

- 500 gallons of fuel (with 10% reserve) will let you cruise up to 1,500 NM at 6.6 kts
- At a maximum cruise speed of 8 kts, consumption is about 4 GPH; at 7.7 kts, 3.0 GPH; at 6.6 kts, 2.0 GPH
- 300 gallons of fresh water (more can be made by adding a water maker)
- 100 gallon holding tank with discharge/macerator pump
- The N37 has easily accessed dry storage in her bos'un locker—there is plenty of room for stores, spares, gear, deep freezer & a washer dryer



On Board Living & Cruising

The Great Harbour N37 has all the features & comforts you'd find in a second home or a vacation condo—only difference is, the N37 let's you take your home with you, whether it's down the coast to Florida in the winter, up to Canada in the summer, or off to the Caribbean.

- Large master stateroom with lots of storage & a real queen-size berth
- Huge galley with room for a 23 cu.ft. refrigerator/freezer, double sink, unequaled work space & peninsula eat-on counter
- Sizeable guest/study with settee that pulls out to a double, hanging locker & desk, doorway into the engine room

- Room to stow spares, oil, tools & machinery manuals
